

Joseph Lallo – Biography – 150 words

Joseph Lallo is a Saxophone Lecturer at the Melbourne Conservatorium of Music and performs internationally as a soloist, chamber musician and conductor. He is the Artistic Director of the Melbourne International Saxophone Festival, and a member of the chamber music ensembles 'Collide', with cellist Yelian He and pianist Yasmin Rowe, and 'Duo Obax', with oboist Briana Leaman. Passionate about performing new Australian music, Joseph has premiered over 30 works for saxophone, and in 2021 recorded Luke Severn's 'and other lines' for ABC Classic. His work as a music curator examines how our experience of music can serve as a model for our connection with the world around us. Joseph's longtime artistic partnership with Jade Norfolk has led to their creation 'Sound of Water', a spatialised and multisensory concert that will include eight world-premiere pieces by Australian composers, to be premiered in Melbourne in 2022.
